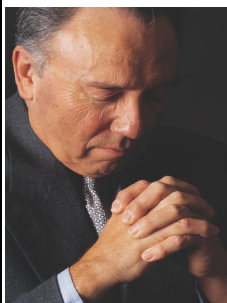
'Stay Focused on What's Important'

Tribute Programme

The Tribute Programme was first started in 1997 as an initiative known as Diakonia, which eventually became known as the Tribute Programme. This programme is open to anybody who is about to hit the job market, or even considering taking a year off between jobs and would like to give the first year of their working life to serve God in a full-time capacity. The intention of creating the opportunity for people to put into practice that which the apostle Paul exhorted in Romans 12:1—'To offer our bodies and souls to be a living sacrifice. This first year, regarded as a 'foundational' year in the workplace, was to be offered to God as the firstfruits of one's labour. 2004 marked a significant year as Tribute was brought up to the Diocese level. Since then, at least forty-one people have passed through the programme.

Spiritual formation is the main goal in Tribute and this is best achieved through involvement in ministry and also personal reflection.

This year, starting 1 February, we have two sisters who will be on the Tribute Programme. They are Ong Xin Ling and Koh Wen Yuan who will be mentored by Revd David Lee and Revd Edwin Tan respectively.

Let us uphold our two beloved sisters in prayer as they embark on this exciting journey with the Lord.

When you expend your time and energy on the few things that make a difference...tasks that aren't exciting or immediately rewarding take on added value. Each activity becomes an important piece in that bigger picture.'

When God gives you a vision He doesn't show you the whole picture up front. He does it in stages so you won't get overwhelmed. For example, when He shared with Moses His vision for delivering Israel, Moses had to wait for each part to download. By faith he left Egypt. By faith he kept the Passover so the enemy wouldn't touch the firstborn of Israel. By faith the Israelites walked through the Red Sea and their enemies drowned trying to pursue them. By faith he kept the Israelites moving for forty years through the wilderness until he stood, an old man, overlooking the Promised Land.

What kept Moses going even after God told him he'd never enter the Promised Land? Simply this: he stayed focused on doing the will of 'Him who is invisible.'
