

Psalm 107:1-9, 43

The book of Psalms is filled with poetry that gives voice to emotions and experiences felt and lived out by the people of Israel. Psalm 107:1-9, 43 is no exception. The Psalmist reminds the people of Israel of God's faithfulness and love. The people of Israel are also reminded of how God is deliverer and provider. God's very nature is love and He cares for all of humanity and creation. His greatest desire is for all of the earth to be reconciled to him: to be gathered and redeemed.

The Psalmist reminds the people of Israel that there was a time of wandering in their history. This time of wandering in the wilderness defined them. He is reminding and bringing before the people the goodness of God and all he has done for them.



We still fall into the same cycle the people of Israel found themselves in: they forgot what God had done for them. We too forget what God has done for us. Why is it that when we remember we focus on the negative?

Do we forget that Christ lived, died and rose again so that we might be in relationship with him... forever? Do we forget that we do not DESERVE grace. That without the life, death, and resurrection of Christ we are separated from God?

The Psalmist is reminding the people that God is good, God is deliverer, and God is provider. May we live out what the Psalmist is reminding us to do in Psalm 107:1-9, 43. May we "give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his steadfast love endures forever."



Pray for the World

The world is fragmented by wars, civil unrest, geopolitical tensions, economic uncertainties and political instabilities. Pray that world leaders will have wisdom, discernment and the political resolve to work together for the good of the global community.

Pray for peace and the rule of law to be restored in places of conflict, for multilateral free trade to replace protectionist policies, for the alleviation of suffering among the poor and the needy and for righteousness to prevail over oppression and injustice.

Pray that in the midst of the darkness, the gospel of light and hope will shine and that many will find in Christ, their true peace and salvation.

Pray for Singapore

Singapore is celebrating 60 years of independence on 9 August 2025. Let us pray for peace and harmony in our land among the people who live in Singapore and our neighbouring countries Malaysia, Brunei and Indonesia. Pray for God's reign on the sphere of influence in our country – cultural, economic, military and politics.

Pray for SACC

Pray for our Sisters of Substance (SOS) as the women in SACC are going for a silent retreat on 13 August that they will find a closer relationship with God.

Pray for the cell groups as they meet regularly weekly or fortnightly that they will build one another in the Word and find encouragement.



Transferring of Tithe/Offering via DBS/POSB banking platform

1) digibank Mobile

- Log in to digibank Mobile with your **Touch / Face ID** or **digibank User ID & PIN**.
- Tap Pay & Transfer and select Local.
- Select the **Recipient** you wish to transfer to: (For Recipient's list refer to Add a Recipient)

- Select the Fund Source you wish to transfer from (e.g. saving account) and enter the Amount you wish to transfer
- Enter your tithe number in 'Reference'
- Tap **Next** to review the details, and tap **Transfer Now** to complete the transfer.

2) Via Paynow

- Select 'PAYNOW' in your banking app
- Bank will send you a 6 digits OTP
- Key in the UEN T08CC4074CEC1 / T08CC4074CCMF / T08CC4074CGF2
- Key in the amount to be transferred.
- Key in your **Tithe number** in the 'Reference' space
- Click 'Transfer'
- Bank will send a text message to you that the amount has been transferred.
- You can send this message to church office.



3) DBS/POSB ATM

- Insert your ATM/Debit Card and key in your PIN.
- Press Button for More Services.
- Press Button for "Funds Transfer/Fixed Deposit".
- Select the Account Type to Debit (your own bank account)
- Select the saving account type and number to Credit

- Enter the amount.
- Verify the **Details of the Transaction** and press **Confirm**.
- Key in your tithe number under reference/bill or send a text to the church office of the transaction: Date of transfer; tithe & amount

4) digibank Online

- Open ibanking portal, login with your **User ID** and **PIN**.
- Select **Transfer** and click **Other DBS or POSB Account**.
- Log in with your 6-Digit iB Secure PIN.
- Choose the Recipient you wish to transfer your money to.
- Select the **Account** you wish to transfer from.
- Select the **Currency** and indicate the **Amount** you wish to transfer.
- Click Next.
- To transfer to a particular payee, you will need to have him/her in your recipient's list.

Adding a recipient to your list.

- Open the ibanking portal, login with your **User ID** and **PIN**.
- Select Transfer and click Add New DBS or POSB Recipient and complete the Authentication Process.
- Indicate the Recipient's name and Account number, click Next.
- Verify the **Details of the Transaction** and follow the **2-Factor Authentication Instructions**.
- Click **Submit** to complete the request.

Digibank Online allows you to set a monthly transfer on desired date.
