

Revd Luke's Sharing:

Dear brothers and sisters,

May the peace and joy of the Lord be with you always!

We give thanks to God for His grace and leading. Over the past six months, the pastoral staff team, leaders, and members of both the Chinese and English congregations have served together in unity, and working hand in hand to advance the Gospel. This truly is a beautiful thing, and may it be pleasing to God.

On August 30, we held a joint leadership retreat for the Chinese and English congregations, with over sixty leaders gathered together. We worshipped together, listened to God's Word, and shared in fellowship. Pastoral staff and leaders presented reports on three important ministries—Family Camp, **The Friend Space**, and the Cambodia Mission. Through in-depth conversations and survey feedback, leaders expressed their vision and burden for these ministries. May we continue to fix our eyes on God in the days ahead, labouring together to be fishers of men for the Lord.

On the evening of October 4, the Chinese congregation hosted a warm Mid-Autumn Festival celebration with about 180 participants. We fellowshiped over a sumptuous potluck meal, tea and moon-gazing, sang festive songs and hymns, listened to the message, played games, and even carried lanterns. It was a meaningful night filled with joy

On October 11, the church celebrated the second anniversary of **The Friend Space**. These two years have been more than the passing of time—they are woven together with precious memories of laughter, heartfelt conversations, and meals shared in love. On that day, about 110 leaders and members from both congregations warmly welcomed nearly 80 newcomers from **The Friend Space**—it has been a long time since we saw so many new faces in our midst! Through games, songs, photos, videos, and a love feast, we enjoyed a beautiful time of fellowship together. **The Friend Space** has become a warm harbour for many new friends, and it continues to serve as a valuable pre-evangelism platform for our brothers and sisters.

On October 19, both congregations held baptism services, with 9 brothers and sisters who were baptized into the name of the Lord. On November 2, we will also be holding confirmation services, with more than 30 members expected to be formally received into church membership. We give thanks to God for continually adding to the church's number! May we press on, forgetting what is behind but toward what is ahead and faithfully living out the Great Commission and making disciples of all nations.

It is also noteworthy that St. Andrew's Community Hospital (Bedok) officially began service on August 11. Rev Yong and the chaplaincy team have already commenced their pastoral ministry there. The hospital is in great need of volunteers to care for the inpatients. We thank God that some of our small groups have already committed to this ministry, and we warmly invite other groups to join, so that our care may be a support and encouragement to those who serve.

Dear brothers and sisters, may this be our prayer together, "Let the favour of the Lord our God be upon us, and establish the work of our hands upon us; yes, establish the work of our hands!" (Psalm 90:17)

May God Himself guide our path ahead, and may we continue to walk together in His grace!

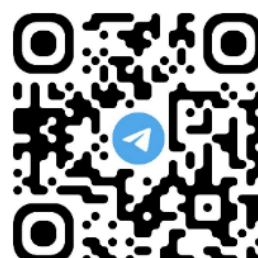

Reflection and discussion questions

1. What does "fear and trembling" have to do with "working out your own salvation"? Why do you think Paul exhorts the Christians in this way?
2. In Philippians 2:14, Paul calls the Philippians to "do all things without grumbling or disputing." In what ways do you think Christians might be tempted to grumble or complain?
3. Read Deuteronomy 32:5 and consider how this compares with Paul's exhortation to the Philippians to be "children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation" (v. 15)?
4. Pray for one another to guard our hearts against the sin of grumbling and complaining, encourage each other to "shine as lights in the world" (Philippians 2:15).

Transferring of Tithe/Offering via DBS/POSB banking platform

1) digibank Mobile

- Log in to digibank Mobile with your **Touch / Face ID** or **digibank User ID & PIN**.
- Tap **Pay & Transfer** and select **Local**.
- Select the **Recipient** you wish to transfer to: *(For Recipient's list refer to Add a Recipient)*
 - o SACC English Congregation 029-900919-2
 - o SACC Cambodia Mission Fund 106-900039-4
 - o SACC Growth Fund 106-900038-6
- Select the **Fund Source** you wish to transfer from (e.g. saving account) and enter the **Amount** you wish to transfer
- Enter your tithe number in '**Reference**'
- Tap **Next** to review the details, and tap **Transfer Now** to complete the transfer.

2) Via Paynow

- Select 'PAYNOW' in your banking app
- Bank will send you a 6 digits OTP
- Key in the UEN T08CC4074CEC1 / T08CC4074CCMF / T08CC4074CGF2
- Key in the amount to be transferred.

- Key in your **Tithe number** in the 'Reference' space
- Click 'Transfer'
- Bank will send a text message to you that the amount has been transferred.
- You can send this message to church office.

3) DBS/POSB ATM

- Insert your ATM/Debit Card and key in your PIN.
- Press Button for **More Services**.
- Press Button for "Funds Transfer/Fixed Deposit".
- Select the Account Type to Debit (your own bank account)
- Select the saving account type and number to Credit
 - o SACC (English) 029-900919-2
 - o SACC Cambodia Mission Fund 106-900039-4
 - o SACC Growth Fund 106-900038-6
- Enter the amount.
- Verify the **Details of the Transaction** and press **Confirm**.
- Key in your **tithe number** under reference/bill or send a text to the church office of the transaction: Date of transfer; tithe & amount

4) digibank Online

- Open ibanking portal, login with your **User ID** and **PIN**.
- Select **Transfer** and click **Other DBS or POSB Account**.
- Log in with your **6-Digit iB Secure PIN**.
- Choose the **Recipient** you wish to transfer your money to.
- Select the **Account** you wish to transfer from.
- Select the **Currency** and indicate the **Amount** you wish to transfer.
- Click **Next**.
- To transfer to a particular payee, you will need to have him/her in your recipient's list.

Adding a recipient to your list.

- Open the ibanking portal, login with your **User ID** and **PIN**.
- Select **Transfer** and click **Add New DBS or POSB Recipient** and complete the **Authentication Process**.
- Indicate the **Recipient's name** and **Account number**, click **Next**.
- Verify the **Details of the Transaction** and follow the **2-Factor Authentication Instructions**.
- Click **Submit** to complete the request.

Digibank Online allows you to set a monthly transfer on desired date.
Follow the instruction in the '**More Services**' button.
